What is assault as far as schools are concerned?

When New York State started violent and disruptive incident reporting (VADIR) for all schools, I noticed that neighboring schools with similar demographics had very different numbers of assaults. Upon further investigation, I discovered that some schools were labeling minor pushing and shoving incidents as assaults, while others weren't. To help the schools I was working with avoid looking more violent than they were, I put together this slide show.

What is an assault?

Assault with Physical Injury: Intentionally or recklessly causing physical injury to another person, with or without a weapon. Physical injury means impairment of physical condition or substantial pain. As a general rule, a physical injury is a minor injury, such as a scrape, minor cut, or minor bruising, that does not involve a risk of death, disability, or disfigurement. Assaults involving injuries that are treated by the school nurse but do not require further medical attention should be included in this

What is a serious assault?

Assault with Serious Physical Injury: Intentionally or recklessly causing serious physical injury to another person, with or without a weapon. **Serious physical injury** means physical injury which creates a substantial risk of death, or which causes serious and protracted disfigurement, protracted impairment of health or protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily organ, i.e, disability. As a general rule, a serious physical injury is one that requires hospitalization or treatment in an emergency room or clinic or treatment by a licensed health professional outside of the school setting and includes, but is not limited to, a bullet wound, a serious stab or puncture wound, fractured or broken bones or teeth, concussions, cuts requiring stitches, and any other injury involving risk of death or disfigurement.

In the adult world, assault can take many forms. In order supply some examples I followed the Brooklyn, New York police beat in the New York Post for several months.
